Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) is administering the **second cycle of state and regional flood planning (2024-2028)**. The Upper Rio Grande Regional Flood Planning Group (RFPG, Region 14) is responsible for developing the 2028 Upper Rio Grande Regional Flood Plan, which will identify existing and future flood risks, recommend strategies for flood mitigation, and identify areas for future study.
