

Before Filing Find Your Precinct.



Eviction suit or Repair and Remedy case must be filed in the precinct where the property is located. A justice court does not have jurisdiction to resolve issues regarding title to real property (*Determining who owns the property*).

Small Claims or Debt Claims case the defendant is entitled to be sued in one of the following venues:

- (1) County and precinct where the defendant lives;
- (2) County and precinct where the incident (*or majority of incidents*) that gave rise to the claim occurred;
- (3) County and precinct where the contract or agreement, if any, that gave rise to the claim was to be performed; or
- (4) County and precinct where the property is located in a suit to recover personal property.

If the *plaintiff* is a non-resident of Texas, or if the *defendant's* residence is unknown, the plaintiff may file the suit in the county and precinct where the plaintiff resides.
