

KINTSUGI COASTER INSTRUCTIONS

What you will need:

White tile

Liquid Gilding – Gold

Paint brush, small, fine tip

Super glue – Loctite Liquid Super Glue

Wax Paper

Hot glue gun

Sealer

Instructions:

- Put tile in paper sack
- Use hammer to hit the back of tile. You can drop the tile on the floor, don't throw it, pieces could come out of the bag and it could shatter into small pieces and you can't put your coaster back together.
- Take tile out of paper sack
- Put tile back together
- Put gold on tile in the crack
- If you put gold on crack on both sides, it can make the gold look thick. If you want gold to look thin, just put it on one side of the crack where they join.
- Put glue where the cracks will join, may need a lot of glue
- Hold the pieces together until they can hold together without holding them
- Once all pieces are glued together, hot glue a piece of felt or cork on the back
- You can use a sealer to keep liquid from staining the coaster

WARNINGS:

The gold may need to be applied twice; it will be light if applied once

The gold will not come off hands without a lot of scrubbing or in your clothing

The glue will stick to your hands and fingers and does not come off easily

Gold will smear on tile if enough time is not given for it to dry

Gold has a strong odor, please use ventilation when using

TIPS:

Be patient with the glue, if you pick it up too early, it will crumble

You may need to add more glue if it doesn't hold and stick together

Alcohol will take off smeared and excess gold. Be careful to not take off the gold you want to keep, or you will have to repaint.
