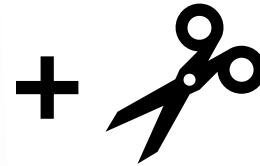
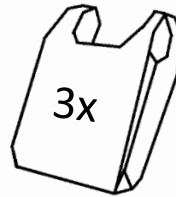


# Make a Water Bottle Holder from Plastic Bags



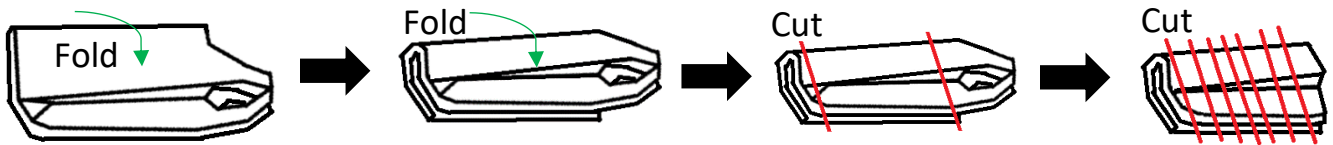
## Materials:

Three plastic grocery bags and a pair of scissors

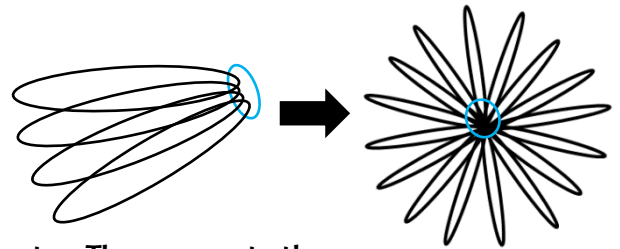


## Instructions:

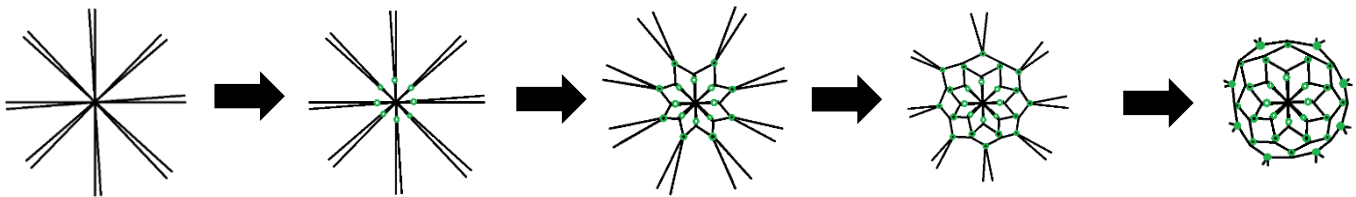
1. Fold two of your bags in half twice, cut the ends and then cut about 1" pieces



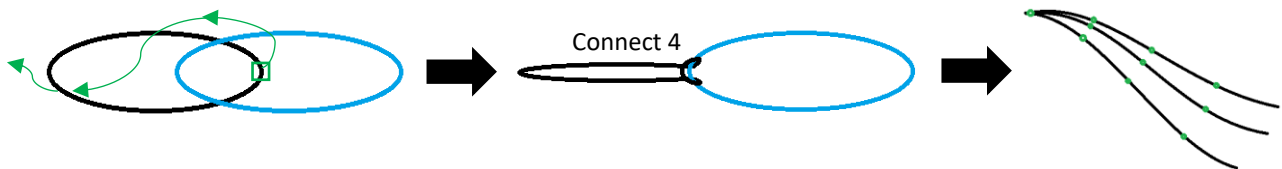
2. Unfold your loops of plastic and take 16 or 20 (this project works best in multiples of 4), tie a scrap plastic bag piece through the loops and spread them out.



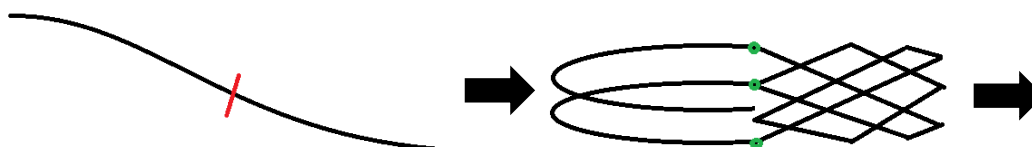
3. Pair up loops and knot them together 1"-2" from the center. Then separate the knotted loops and pair them with a loop next to it from a different knot. Continue this until you run out of room to knot and then tie the last knots as double knots. Cut off the extra plastic, leaving at least 1/2".



4. Take the last bag and cut it just like in step one, but this time making sure that there are 12 loops cut in total, so they will need to be cut smaller than before. Connect 4 loops together like below, making 3 separate strands. Knot them together at the end and braid the strands together.



5. Cut the rope in half and tie the two straps to your bottle bag.



And now you're done!
