# How to make a Paper Pumpkin!



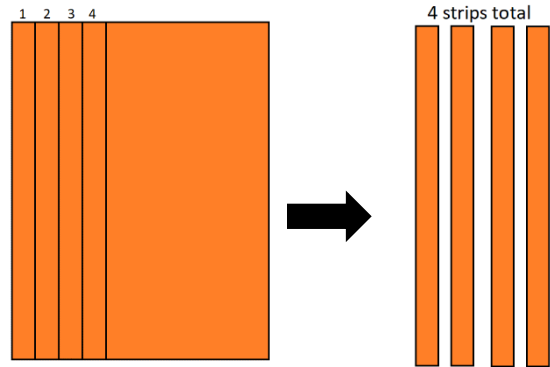
## Materials:

One orange paper and one green paper (or paper colored with marker or color pencil)

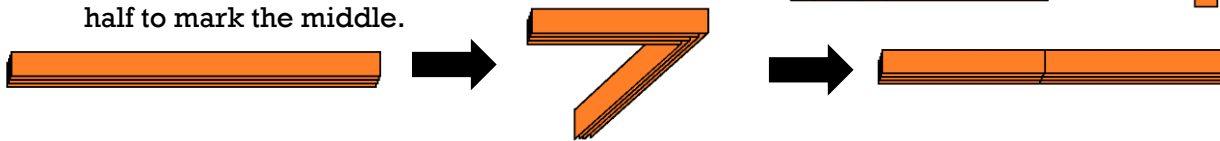
Note: if you color the paper with a marker, let it dry before starting the construction

## Instructions:

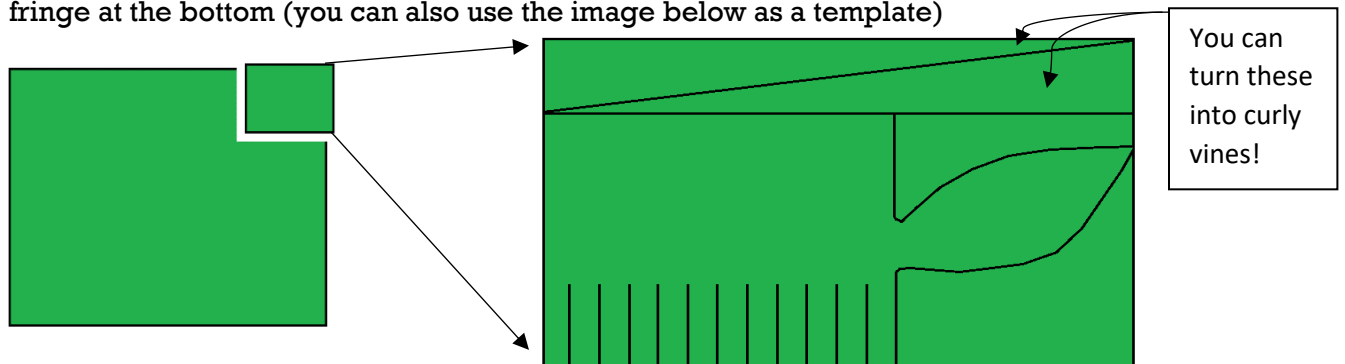
1. Take your orange paper and cut it long ways in 4 strips (between one half to a full inch).



2. Stack the strips together and then fold them in half to mark the middle.



3. Cut an approximately 1.5 by 3 inch rectangle out of the green paper and cut a leaf out one side and fringe at the bottom (you can also use the image below as a template)



4. Glue the orange strips together at the center. Glue the ends into rings to make a sphere. Glue and roll the green cutout. Spread out the fringe and press on to the top of the orange sphere
