



COMMISSIONERS COURT RULES OF CONDUCT:

1. PERSONS other than Elected County Officials or Department Heads are requested to sign in on the notebook located on the table in the entry foyer.
2. NON-COURT members must be recognized by the County Judge before addressing the Court.
3. THE JUDGE may impose a time limit of two minutes upon the non-court members or may waive the time limit in the case of elected officials or staff members making a presentation to the Court.
4. QUESTIONS of the Speaker shall come from the Commissioners Court. Others seeking clarification, may request permission from the Judge to ask a question of the Speaker.
5. ALL comments shall be focused on the issues before the Court as stated on agenda.
6. ALL parties shall treat each other with respect. No name calling, derogatory statements or inappropriate language or gestures will be permitted. **No personal attacks.** Other speakers shall not be interrupted, except by the County Judge to impose time limits or enforce the rules of the Court. Speakers or attendees who violate this rule may be warned once, upon any violation the person will be removed.
7. NON-COURT members violating the rules may be asked to leave. The bailiff may be instructed to remove the person from the Courtroom.
