

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**Texas Local Government Code**

**Sec. 232.005. Enforcement in General .**

**A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a requirement established by, or adopted by the commissioners court under a preceding section of this chapter. An offense under this subsection is a Class B misdemeanor.**

This is notice that you have violated the following requirements as established by the Commissioners Court of Midland County under Texas Local Government Code.

**Sec. 232.001 – Plat Required**

The owner of a tract of land located outside the limits of a municipality must have a plat of the subdivision prepared if the owner divides the tract into 2 or more parts to lay out.

- (1) Failure to obtain a plat

**Sec. 245.001 – Permit Required to do any work within the County Right of Way.**

- (1) No Drive Way Permit obtained prior to tying into County Road.
- (2) Utilizing County Right of Way without obtaining Permit.

**Order Establishing Regulations for Flood Damage Prevention. (See Midland County Flood Plain Management.)**

Development means any man made change to improved or unimproved real estate, including but not limited to buildings or other structures, mining, dredging, filling, grading, paving, excavation or drilling operations or storage of equipment or materials.

- (1) Failure to Obtain Flood Plain Permit prior to work being done in flood plain.

The person receiving this notice has 30 days to contact the Midland County Public works sections to rectify these issues.
