Texas State Law outlines the specific duties and responsibilities of a Constable.

The Constable is responsible for serving all civil process and carrying out the orders issued out of the Justice Court (and any other authorized court) and to provide for the safety of that court and to be present during active court sessions.

Constables are licensed Peace Officers and have full law enforcement authority, as do all Licensed Peace Officers.
