


## Download & Install FortiClient

1. Connect to your home internet or mobile jetpack.
2. Go to <https://forti.mcounty.com:10443/installers/Default/FCT.722/>

3. For Windows PC select "FortiClientSetup\_724\_x64.exe" the Windows 64 bit agent.

Click the downloaded program to install the VPN Client.




5. Clicking "Next" on all dialogue boxes will be fine for the install. Click Finish. Follow the directions below to connect.

### Steps to connect to FortiClient (VPN):


1. Connect to your home INTERNET or mobile Jetpack.
2. On your Desktop icons locate a blue icon with a shield "Forticlient" click on it to open it



3. Once opened under Zero Trust Telemetry. Enter invitation code "forti.mcounty.com" and Connect




4. After connecting click on the tab Remote Access  
5. Username and password are the same as PC credentials




6. Have you cell phone and have the DUO Mobile app open. You will need to approve the connection.

## Steps to run Remote Desktop


1. Open Remote Desktop by going to the Windows Icon and typing Remote.
2. Click Remote Desktop Connection




3. Enter your office computer name or Ip address and click connect  
Your office computer name will be department (ie “da”) followed by the 5-digit Midland County tag number found on the **Blue Sticker** on your tower. Ex: da01234 .Some PCs may still have an older naming convention, so if you’re unable to locate your PC name, please contact IT x4830.



9. Enter your credentials: Type in your username and password. This will be the same username and password you use to login to your work computer. User name needs to be in the following format: **Midco\”your username”**. Make sure you are entering the Midco\ (ie: midco\hmargeson)



10. Check the “Do not ask me again for connections to this computer” and click “Yes”



If all the steps are followed you will now be connected to your office computer.
